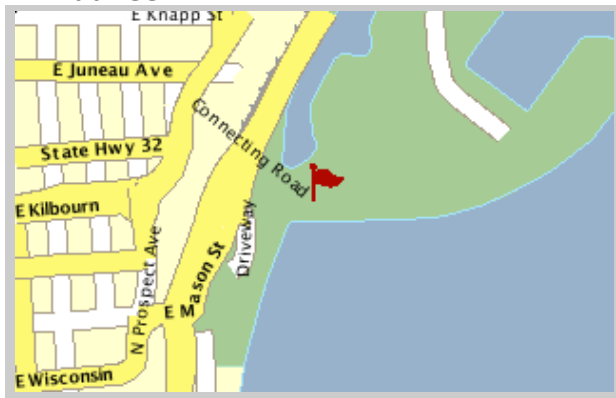

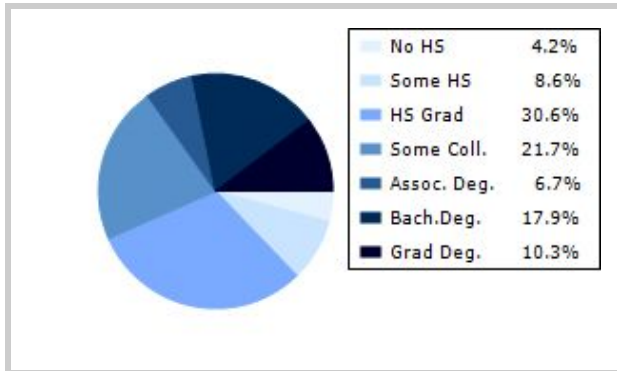

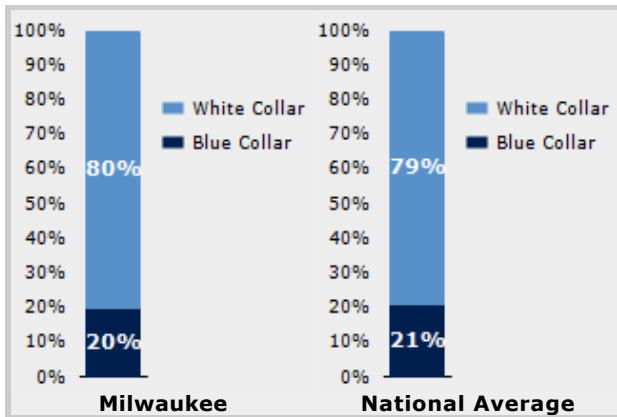

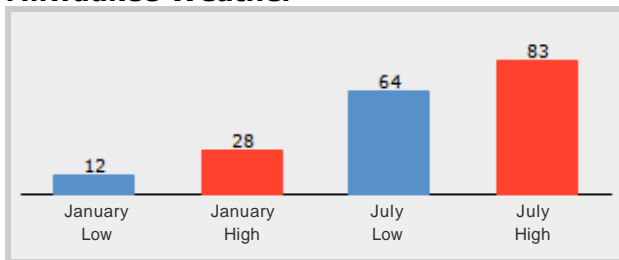

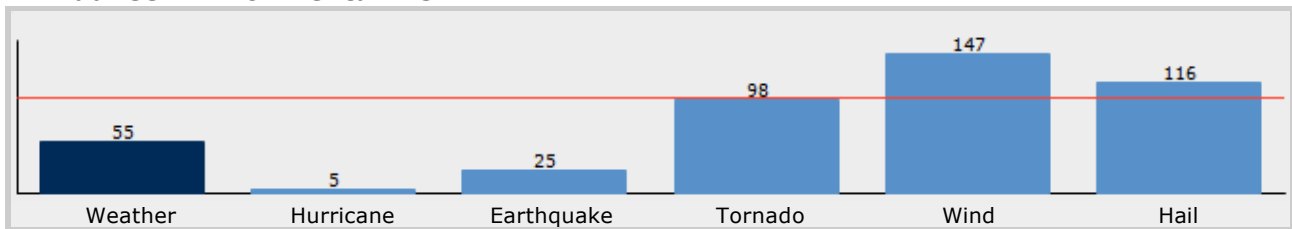

Milwaukee Environmental Risk





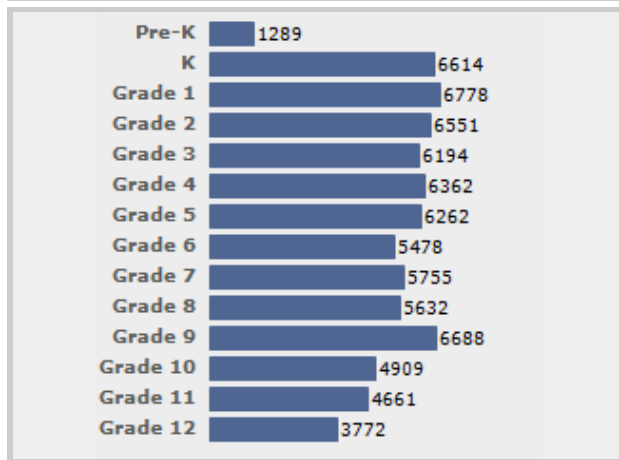

The School information provided in this report is updated on an ongoing basis throughout the year. From June through mid-September, core data on public schools and school districts is collected. That data is collected by phone to capture the latest changes in key district personnel, school openings and closures, and restructuring of school districts.

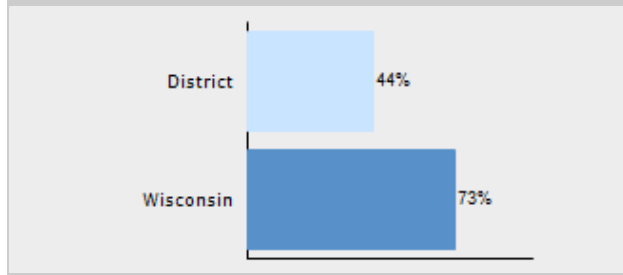
During the core update, phone numbers, fax numbers, grade spans, enrollments and other data specifics regarding program offerings such as before/after school programs, etc. are updated as well.

On a rolling basis throughout the year, additional updates and verification efforts are performed through mail surveys, websites and telephone interviews. The most recent mail survey culminated in 590,000 updates sent by school secretaries from across the country.

These collection efforts are supplemented by other resources including the National Center for Education Statistics and local Departments/Boards of Education.

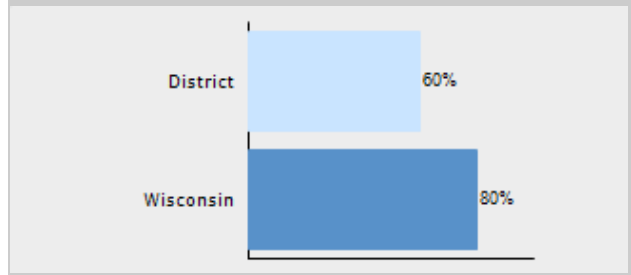
